Current Achievement and targets


- 37% achieving a E or D – Move 60% to a C standard
- 27 % of Students achieving a C Standard – move 60% of students to a B standard.
- 30% of Students achieving a B Standard – Move 25% of students to an A standard.

Our initiatives include

- 1) Collect and analyse relevant data to inform teaching and learning strategies for individual student
- 2) Develop learning goals for all student in:
 - Reading
 - Writing
- 3) Record learning goals in OneSchool under individual profiles
- 4) Establish processes for regular data analysis and collaborative planning sessions at staff meetings.
- 5) Design support programs for students to achieve their goals with in class support and targeted intervention of at risk students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- 1) \$ 10,000 to purchase additional TA time in the classroom to support the students with their learning goals and work with students who are identified at risk.
- 2) \$10,471 to purchase addiotnal ta time to work 1-1 with students who are identified at significantly below learning targets and will also work with students marginally below targets to support their individual learning progression.
